

THE HOLY SEED WILL BE THE STUMP IN THE LAND

“And though a tenth remains in the land, it will again be laid waste. But as the terebinth and oak leave stumps when they are cut down, so the holy seed will be the stump in the land.”
(Isaiah 6:13)



Bible passage (Isaiah 6:1-13)

“1 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. 2 Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. 3 And they were calling to one another: “Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory.” 4 At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. 5 “Woe to me!” I cried. “I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty.” 6 Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. 7 With it he touched my mouth and said, “See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for.” 8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?” And I said, “Here am I. Send me!” 9 He said, “Go and tell this people: “‘Be ever hearing, but never understanding; be ever seeing, but never perceiving.’ 10 Make the heart of this people calloused; make their ears dull and close their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts, and turn and be healed.” [...]

Message

In Isaiah chapter 6, the prophet Isaiah encounters the holy God personally in the temple. Isaiah recognizes that God is the sovereign and almighty ruler over the whole world. God cleanses Isaiah's unclean lips from his shepherd's heart and appoints him as his messenger to his people. Although the people are very obdurate and they would reject his message, God carries out his work of salvation through a small remnant that he has left. They are the remnant who hear and proclaim God's word as holy seeds. These remnant are the holy stumps of God through whom God continues His history. Let us lift up our eyes to Almighty God, the sovereign ruler of the world, accept God's voice of calling, and be used as the holy stumps for this generation.
