(4:9, 11-13, 20, 33-34) How can we experience the secrets of God's kingdom? What do these parables teach about Jesus' ministry and his shepherd heart for his people and disciples?
- 2. What and why did Jesus reveal about himself to the disciples in storm training (4: 35-41) How did Jesus heal a demon possessed man, Jairus' daughter and a bleeding woman? (5:1-43) What did Jesus reveal and what did the disciples learn through these events? What did Jesus teach about shepherd life and faith? (4:40-41, 5:34, 36, 6:6)?

- 3. What let Jesus his Apostles experience through the rejection in Nazareth and sending them out? (6:1-13) What does the martyrdom of John the Baptist tell us about those days? (6:14-29) Why did Jesus command his disciples to give the crowd something to eat? (6:30-38) What did the disciples learn about Jesus and his spiritual leadership through feeding the five thousand? (6:34, 37, 8:2-3)
- 4. What did Jesus show to his disciples by walking on the water and by rebuking the Pharisees? (6:45-52, 7:1-23, 8:14-21) How is Jesus' leadership different from that of the religious leaders? What did Jesus reveal about himself through his healing ministry for three groups of people? (7:24 8:9) What historical meaning had Peter's confession, "You are the Messiah"? (8:27-30) How could Peter declare such a confession?
