With what request did Moses pray when God spoke to him about his death? (12-17) How did God establish Moses' successor? (18-23) What did Moses prepare for the handing over of his leadership? (22,23) What can we learn from God, who did not allow Moses to proceed into Canaan?

Which offering was to be repeatedly offered during each festival? (28:10,15,31; 29:6,11,16,19,22,25,34) Why did God speak about the festivals and the offering before the entry into Canaan? What did God say about vows? (4-16)
